Pursuant to the Article 1, paragraph (3) of the Law on Communications of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", No. 31/03, 75/06, 32/10 and 98/12), and related to the Article 3, paragraph (2) and Article 8, paragraph (1) item h) of the Law on the Agency for Identification Documents, Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", No. 56/08) and Article 17 of the Law on the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", No. 30/03, 42/03, 81/06, 76/07, 81/07, 94/07 and 24/08), at the proposal of the Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina at the 64th session, held on 18 September 2013, issued

DECISION

ON DETERMINING THE MANNER OF USING THE EXISTING TELECOMMUNICATION NETWORKS IN THE INSTITUTIONS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA FOR THE PURPOSES OF DATA EXCHANGE AND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT IN INSTITUTIONS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

(Subject)

This Decision regulates the manner of using the existing telecommunication networks owned by Bosnia and Herzegovina for data exchange between the Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina and other institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Article 2

(Data exchange)

- (1) Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina exchanges data through licenced network for data transmission (hereinafter: network) established in accordance with the Law on Agency for Identification Documents, Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", No.56/08), with the following institutions which are users of the network: Agency for Identification Documents, Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina, (hereinafter: IDDEEA), Indirect Taxation Authority of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Ministry of Security of Bosnia and Herzegovina, State Investigation and Protection Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Directorate for Coordination of Police Bodies of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Border Police of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Service for Foreigners' Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Ministry of Defence of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Intelligence Security Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina, High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Central Election Commission and other institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina which have police authorizations or which belong to the defence system.
- (2) Data exchange through the network is related to the use of the existing systems governed by the Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and the institutions referred to in paragraph (1) of this article perform the following tasks:
 - a) Data exchange related to the charge and control of incomes based on fines for infringements and data exchange related to the charge and control of incomes based on the issuance of personal documents, and other incomes within IDDEEA's jurisdiction;

- b) Data exchange related to the planning and monitoring of the execution of the Budget of BiH institutions and international obligations of Bosnia and Herzegovina;
- c) Data exchange related to the system of treasury business;
- d) Data exchange related to the centralized system for accounting salaries and benefits;
- e) Data exchange related to other information systems regarding the financial business of institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina;
- f) Data exchange with subjects of payment operations in case of conducting electronic payments based on fines for infringements and data exchange related to the charge and control of incomes based on the issuance of personal documents, and other incomes within IDDEEA's jurisdiction.
- (3) The use of network by the Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina is based on security standards defined by IDDEEA in accordance with the Law on Agency for Identification Documents, Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in terms of using the communication equipment and standards related to the communication security.
- (4) Data exchange for institutions referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article is performed by using the existing equipment used by budget users.
- (5) Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina is obliged to perform the replacement of the existing equipment in accordance with the technical requirements arising from the obligation for the implementation of security standards.

Article 3

(The use of resources for other institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina)

- (1) Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina can exchange data with other institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina and budget users via network based on the use of the systems referred to in Article 2, paragraph (2) of this Decision, if technical conditions are provided and with the obligatory implementation of security standards according to the provisions of the Article 2, paragraph (3) of this Decision.
- (2) Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina is obliged to submit a request to IDDEEA for determining the fulfilment of technical conditions and security standards, and assent for network use in these cases before connecting to network to institutions referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article.

Article 4

(Ensuring assets and technical conditions for the implementation of the Decision)

- (1) Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall plan and perform within the budget the procurement of the communication equipment necessary for functioning of data exchange system via network for users referred to in Article 3 of this Decision.
- (2) IDDEEA shall provide technical support for the introduction and commissioning of the system for data exchange and ensure availability of standards regarding the protection of security of data exchange.
- (3) Institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina are responsible for the implementation of security standards related to the network use.

Article 5

(Responsibility for implementation)

Ministry of Finance and Treasury of Bosnia and Herzegovina, IDDEEA and institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina which shall use the network for data exchange are responsible for the implementation of this Decision.

Article 6

(Entry into force)

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption and shall be published in "Official Gazette of BiH".
