Pursuant to Article 19, paragraph (1) of the Law on Travel Documents of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", No.1/99, 9/99, 27/00, 32/00, 19/01, 47/04, 53/07, 15/08, 33/08 and 39/08), Article 61 of the Law on Administration ("Official Gazette of BiH, No. 32/02 and 102/09) and Article 19, paragraph (2) of the Law on Agency for Identification Documents, Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH, number 56/08), Director of the Agency for Identification Documents, Registers and Data Exchange of Bosnia and Herzegovina issues

GUIDELINES ON THE AMENDMENTS TO THE GUIDELINES ON MANNER OF ELECTRONIC DATA VERIFICATION

Article 1

In the Guidelines on manner of electronic data verification ("Official Gazette of BiH", No. 45/09) after Article 3, Article 3a is added and says:

"Article 3a (Exemption of data verification)

- (1)Data which competent authorities for issuance of identity cards or travel documents collect during the verification at the competent municipal authority in the process of issuance of identity card or travel documents are valid for 60 days in accordance with the provisions of entity Laws on the Registry Books and the Law on the Registry Books of Brcko District which stipulate that excerpts from birth registry books have unlimited validity.
- (2) Within the meaning of paragraph (1) of this Article, the competent authority for the issuance of identity cards or travel documents shall not repeat data verification in the competent municipal authority and shall accept results of the previous verification performed in the procedure of the issuance of identity cards or travel documents, if the period from the day of handing over the identity card or travel documents to a person to the day of submitting the application for issuance of identity card or travel documents by the same person is no longer than 60 days and if the data gained by the previous verification are in compliance with data listed in the form of the application.
- (3) Form of the application for the issuance of identity cards or travel documents is legally considered also as the statement of a party to the competent authority and the applicant is obliged to give correct and true data in the application.
- (4) In case of disagreement of data gained by the previous verification in the procedure of issuance of identity cards or travel documents with data listed in the form of application, competent authority for issuance of identity cards or travel documents shall initiate the procedure of re-verification in accordance with Article 3 of these Guidelines."

Article 2

The provisions of these Guidelines shall be applied for all applications submitted upon the entry into force of these Guidelines.

Article 3

These Guidelines shall enter into force on the eight day after the publication in the "Official Gazette of BiH".
