**GUIDELINES  
ON THE AMENDMENTS TO THE GUIDELINES ON MANNER OF  
CONFISCATION AND ANNULMENT OF TRAVEL DOCUMENTS**

Article 1

(Confiscation of travel document)

In Article 2 of the Guidelines on the manner of confiscation and annulment of travel documents ("Official Gazette of BiH" No. 55/09), (hereinafter: Guidelines), after paragraph 2, a new paragraph (3) shall be added and says:

"(3) In the termination process of citizenship of Bosnia and Herzegovina by renunciation, a competent official shall confiscate a valid travel document when delivering the decision on renunciation of citizenship to a holder of valid travel document of Bosnia and Herzegovina. A relevant certificate shall be issued on confiscated travel document. Along with the decision on renunciation of citizenship of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the confiscated travel document is also submitted to competent authority for annulment."

Article 2

(Annulment of travel document)

In Article 6 paragraph (1) of the Guidelines, after the words: "forged data", the following words shall be added: "which is not delivered within 90 days as of the expiry of the deadline for the issuance of travel document envisaged by law."

Article 3

(Entry into force)

These Guidelines shall enter into force on the eight day of its publication in the "Official Gazette of BiH".
