

Pursuant to Article 19 paragraph (6) of the Law on Travel Documents of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", Nos. 4/97, 1/99, 9/99, 27/00, 32/00, 19/01, 47/04, 53/07, 15/08, 33/08, 39/08 and 60/13), the Ministry of Civil Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina issues

**GUIDELINES**  
**ON THE AMENDMENTS TO THE GUIDELINES ON THE PROCEDURE, PRICE**  
**AND JURISDICTION OF THE AUTHORITIES RESPONSIBLE FOR ISSUING**  
**OF TRAVEL DOCUMENTS WITHIN THE DEADLINE SHORTER THAN PRESCRIBED**

Article 1

(Resolving applications)

(1) In Article 2 paragraph (2) of the Guidelines on the procedure, price and jurisdiction of the authorities responsible for issuing of travel documents within the deadline shorter than prescribed, after words: "48 hours", a comma and the following text are added: "if the application is submitted in Bosnia and Herzegovina, or 7 days if the application is submitted in a Diplomatic Consular Representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina abroad."

(2) In the same Article after paragraph (4) paragraph (5) is added and says:

"(5) Competent authorities for the issuance of travel documents shall enable applicants to submit applications for the issuance of travel document within a deadline shorter than prescribed immediately after they submit application for the issuance of identity card."

Article 2

(Travel document price)

In Article 4, paragraph (2) after words: "200 BAM" a full stop is replaced with a comma and the following text is added: "and the price of travel document issued in a Diplomatic Consular Representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina abroad is 250 € (EUR).

Article 3

(Entry into force)

Guidelines on the amendments to the Guidelines on the procedure, price and jurisdiction of the authorities responsible for issuing of travel documents within the deadline shorter than prescribed shall enter into force on the eight day of its publication in "Official Gazette of BiH".
