

Pursuant to the Article IV.4.a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the 50h session of the House of Representatives held on 18 July 2013 and at the 33rd session of the House of Peoples held on 5 November 2013 has adopted the

**LAW ON
AMENDMENTS TO THE LAW ON
PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER**

Article 1

In the Law on Personal Identification Number ("Official Gazette of BiH", nos. 32/01, 63/08 and 103/11) Article 5 is amended and says:

"Article 5

Registers (IV group) in Republic of Srpska are as follows:

1. Register number 11 for registration areas: Banja Luka, Čelinac, Gradiška, Istočni Drvar, Jezero, Kneževo, Kostajnica, Kotor Varoš, Kozarska Dubica, Krupa na Uni, Kupres, Laktaši, Mrkonjić Grad, Novi Grad, Oštra Luka, Petrovac, Prijedor, Prnjavor, Ribnik, Srbac i Šipovo.
2. Register number 12 for registration areas: Bijeljina, Brod, Derventa, Doboj, Donji Žabar, Lopare, Modriča, Pelagićevo, Petrovo, Teslić, Ugljevik, Vukosavlje i Šamac.
3. Register number 13 for registration areas: Bileća, Berkovići, Bratunac, Čajniče, Foča, Gacko, Han Pijesak, Istočna Ilidža, Istočni Mostar, Istočni Stari Grad, Istočno Novo Sarajevo, Kalinovik, Ljubinje, Milici, Nevesinje, Novo Goražde, Osmaci, Pale, Rogatica, Rudo, Srebrenica, Sokolac, Šekovići, Trebinje, Trnovo, Višegrad, Vlasenica i Zvornik.

Registers (IV group) for Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina are as follows:

1. Register number 14 for registration area: Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Registers (IV group) in Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina are as follows:

1. Register number 15 for registration areas: Čapljina, Čitluk, Grude, Jablanica, Konjic, Ljubuški, Mostar, Neum, Posušje, Prozor, Ravno, Stolac i Široki Brijeg.
2. Register number 16 for registration areas: Bihać, Bosanska Krupa, Bosanski Petrovac, Bosansko Grahovo, Bužim, Cazin, Drvar, Glamoč, Ključ, Kupres, Livno, Sanski Most, Tomislavgrad i Velika Kladuša.
3. Register number 17 for registration areas: Centar Sarajevo, Foča, Goražde, Hadžići, Ilidža, Ilijaš, Novo Sarajevo, Pale, Sarajevo Novi Grad, Sarajevo Stari Grad, Trnovo I Vogošća.
4. Register number 18 for registration areas: Banovići, Čelić, Doboj-Istok, Domaljevac-Šamac, Gračanica, Gradačac, Kalesija, Kladanj, Lukavac, Odžak, Orašje, Sapna, Srebrenik, Teočak, Tuzla i Živinice.
5. Register number 19 for registration areas: Bugojno, Breza, Busovača, Doboj-Jug, Dobretići, Donji Vakuf, Fojnica, Gornji Vakuf, Jajce, Kakanj, Kiseljak, Kreševo, Maglaj, Novi Travnik, Olovo, Travnik, Tešanj, Usora, Vareš, Visoko, Vitez, Zavidovići, Zenica i Žepče."

Article 2

After Article 5, a new Article 5a shall be added and say:

"Article 5a

Personal identification number which is designated according to the provisions adopted before the adoption of this Law, and which defined registration areas and titles of municipalities in Bosnia and Herzegovina, shall not be changed."

Article 3

This Law shall enter into force on the eight day of its publication in the "Official Gazette of BiH.
